



## HOW DOES LDSHOMESHARE WORK?

Have you ever thought it would be fun to stay with other LDS families in cities across the USA instead those expensive hotels, motels or bed and breakfasts?

What a wonderful way to make new friends with members from across the country and save lots of money!

### IT'S EASY AND INEXPENSIVE TO USE

To use the LDSHomeShare system, please print this page and follow the instructions:

1. JOIN: It is free to join and register. Just click on the LIST MY HOME link on the home page and it will take you to the **registration/sign in** page.
  - a. If this is the **first time** to SIGN IN, find and fill out the area that reads: Don't have an account? Just enter your e-mail and postal code. That's it!!
  - b. If you are **already a member**, enter your email/screen name and password in the requested area.
  - c. Remember your password. To sign the next time, use your email (or screen name) and password,
  - d. You will be assigned and emailed a PASSWORD at this time. Your USER NAME is your email address. You can change or edit both your PASSWORD and your USER NAME (screen name). Do this at a later time. When you are ready to change your USER NAME (SCREEN NAME) and PASSWORD follow these instructions:
    - i. Once you are a member and are signed in, find the link on Home Page titled: ACCOUNT PREFERENCES (Near top and to the right): Click on link. Next, open the link titled EDIT MY USER ACCOUNT. You can now change your SCREEN NAME and PASSWORD. Use new SCREEN NAME and PASSWORD the next time you log in.
    - ii. LIST YOUR HOME. Go to the home page, click on HOW TO LIST YOUR HOME, print it out, and follow instructions.
2. INVITE: ***PLEASE help us GROW the membership!***

We thank you for your interest to become a member and user of LDSHomeShare. To have this network work well we need each MEMBER to participate in inviting others to join and use the site. Invite ward members, friends, missionary companions,

family etc. Remember, membership is free, and we NEED your help to grow. We have made it very easy to email all your LDS friends and family from across the nation. If you don't have someone's email, just give them a call, get their email address, and let them know they will be receiving an email from you. The reason you want them to enroll through your email is when they join they will be linked to you, and you will find them in your FRIENDS AND FAMILY area (Described below). Simply go to the Homepage and find link titled **Invite My Friends and Family**. Click the link.

Next, you will be able to draft an email (Please remove and type your own invitation message.)

Next, add all your email addresses. Send your email.

***A great feature of our system is that it will track and link each new member to the person who invited them through the email invitation. As each of your friends/family invites their friends/family, they will now be linked together, resulting in linkage from friend to friend to friend. You will be able to find friends and family of your friends and family since all members are linked together. This linkage goes six generations deep. This helps in locating members in a trusted network linkage system. You will find this linkage under the MY ACCOUNT link on the Home Page.***

## USE THE SYSTEM

1. When you are ready to find a LDSHomeShare member to stay with, open and follow the instructions in the link named HOW TO REQUEST A PLACE TO STAY.
2. To keep our network system viable LDSHomeShare requests each time you stay with another member that you make a donation. Usage of LDSHomeShare is on the honor system. If possible please donate 5-20% of what you would have paid at a hotel etc.

For example: You overnight 2 nights at other LDSHomeShare member homes. You normally spend \$70 a night for a hotel.  $2 \times \$70 = \$140$ . You decide to donate about 10% - \$15. You save \$125. Use the savings to buy gasoline!!!
